

NOTICE TO RECIPIENTS OF EMAIL MESSAGES

The authenticity of the sender and the contents are not guaranteed, with the exception of digitally signed documents.

Furthermore, pursuant to art. 13 GDPR 679/16, the email addresses relating to natural persons, companies, entities with whom previous communications have taken place, or that were provided to us when filling out the forms published on our website or through other direct contacts, are stored in our archives. As they are used by us, in compliance with the will and availability of the interested parties, to send communications via email from our company.

We also inform you that all mailboxes of the domain "...@consorzioniver.it" are work tools and, as such, are used for communications in the work environment. Therefore, for needs related to operational activity, any message, both outgoing and incoming, could be read by persons other than the sender and/or the recipient.
